Presentation to the Board Members, Duck Key Property Owners, Monroe County Sheriff Department, and Monroe County IT Department of the Security Cameras Installed at the Truman Bridge

David Maggiore, Daniel Plaza, and Troy Smith arrived from Ft. Lauderdale to give a computer screen tour of the new cameras installed on the Truman Bridge. The north camera on the bridge which views the incoming Duck Key traffic was offline but still recording the DVR at the box on the pole. Clark Briggs called Comcast to see if it was connection issue. The south camera which views the out bound traffic was online. The Tyco/Bosch reps needed to install more software so all computer systems could view the video. At this date, only the browser Internet Explorer version 9 and 10 was online. The browsers Safari, Chrome, Firefox would be able to view the video after the updated software to the modems located in the 2 boxes on the poles.

Questions were asked and answered regarding several topics on how to operate the log-in to the IP address of the cameras, number of people at one time on the IP site, how Duck Key homeowners could view the video, and general internet questions if the cameras go offline and what steps to take to get the site online.
