Notice of Website Update - Revised

The Monroe County website home page will receive layout updates on Thursday August 1, 2013.

The Monroe County Website will receive updates to its main layout and basic navigation. Updates will occur during the day on Thursday, and should be complete by 5p.m. EST.

Users that use the set of “quick links” in the purple area of the home page will be most affected. Many of the links will be moved to other sections of the website. To help users find information that has moved, from the purple middle section of the page, double click the link titled “Where is my missing link?” on www.monroecounty-fl.gov for more information.

A new section named “Programs” will replace the current section named “Business.” This section will showcase important current initiatives by Monroe County Administration. You will be able to access this section from the “Programs” button at the top, or the “Current Initiatives” button from the purple middle highlights section of the home page.

The “Business” section will be migrated to the “Residents” section, as the content of the business section applies to residents.

The top button labeled “About Monroe County” will be changed to read “County Commission.” The link will be changed to directly link to the Districts & Members of the Monroe County Commission. The history of Monroe County will be accessible as a subpage option to the commissioner’s page.
