The NASKW EIS Oversight Committee convened at 1:00 P.M. at 500 Whitehead Street, Suite 102 in the office of District 1 Commissioner Danny Kolhage. Present were Roman Gastesi, County Administrator, Don Riggs, John Hammerstrom, Commissioner Danny Kolhage, and Richard Shetzer. Kim Wigington attended via teleconference. Also present were Christine Hurley, Growth Management Director, and Mayte' Santamaria, Assistant Planning and Environmental Resources Director. Members from the press and general public were also present.

Item I. Roll call was taken with all committee members present.

Item II. Motion was made by Mr. Gastesi and seconded by Mr. Shetzer approving the agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

Item III. Motion was made by Mr. Shetzer and seconded by Mr. Riggs to approve the minutes of the August 14, 2013 meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Items IV & V. An update was presented to the committee by Michael Davis and John Abbott, with the firm Keith & Schnars concerning the release of the Naval Air Station (NAS) Key West Airfield Operations FINAL Environmental Impact Statement (EIS); the Navy's three action alternatives or a No Action Alternative; and the County's unresolved concerns in the EIS. The committee discussed the maximum limit on all types of flight operations, noise mitigation, a noise baseline analysis, and flight patterns. After discussion, the committee voted unanimously to adopt a resolution which authorizes the County Administrator and Keith & Schnars to represent the County in conversations and meetings with Senior Navy policy officials, the White House Council on Environmental Quality, the White House Intergovernmental Affairs and members of the Florida Congressional Delegation to fully express the County's continuing concerns with the FEIS before the Record of Decision is finalized on the NASK FEIS. Motion carried unanimously.
