Meeting Date: June 16, 2015

The following comments were heard during the June 15, 2015 public meeting and are provided for inclusion into the County's meeting notes.

1. One woman suggested nothing be done with the site recreationally. She advocated for a boutique hotel as an amenity to the community and revenue source. She felt the County would do what they wanted to do since it had been funded and they were obviously paying consultants to do work. I let her know that we were there as part of the public involvement phase and that it was up to the public input and the County's direction to proceed and how to proceed.
2. A live-aboard gentleman, a retiree from GM stated that the mess on the island was not from the live-aboards but from those camping on the site. He said they come ashore at the site and travel through it to get to their destinations.
3. Two women commented about the URS traffic report's findings not being accurate to the current year's traffic levels and how there are seasonal traffic levels that contradict the findings. One of the two mentioned that the east bound sightline issues are present and improvements would be required for safe entry and exit movements.
4. One woman suggested a boat ramp.
5. One gentleman suggested more mooring buoys and docking space for dinghies.
