ORDINANCE NO. 018 -1991

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS PROVIDING FOR THE ADDITION OF SUBSECTION (D) TO SECTION 6-85 OF THE MONROE COUNTY CODE; SAID SUBSECTION SHALL PROVIDE FOR THE REMOVAL OF A MEMBER OF THE CONTRACTOR'S EXAMINING BOARD FOR EXCESSIVE ABSENTEEISM; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT HEREWITH; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION INTO THE MONROE COUNTY CODE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MONROE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. Subsection 6-85(d) is hereby added to read as follows:

Any member of the Contractor's Examining Board who absents himself from any three (3) consecutive regular meetings of said Contractor's Examining Board, unless excused from such attendance by consent of the Board, expressed by action of record in its official minutes, or who is absent from a total of four (4) regular meetings of said Board in any fiscal year without having been excused from such attendance by consent of the Board expressed by action of record in its official minutes, shall thereby automatically forfeit his position and office as a member of the Contractor's Examining Board; and the name of such person shall be automatically removed from the membership of said Board immediately after the adjournment of any such third consecutive meeting or any such fourth meeting in any fiscal year, as the case may be, at which such member has not appeared. The Board shall thereupon promptly notify the member so removed and the Board of County Commissioners for Monroe County shall thereupon appoint a new member to serve the remainder of the unexpired term of the member so removed.

Section 2. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is held invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected by such invalidity.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of said conflict.

Section 4. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be included and incorporated in the Code of Ordinances of the County

of Monroe, Florida, as an addition or amendment thereto, and shall be appropriately renumbered to conform to the uniform numbering system of the Code.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon receipt of official notice from the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of Florida that this Ordinance has been filed with said Office.
