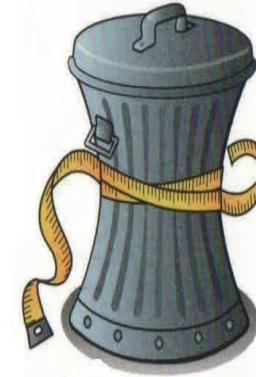

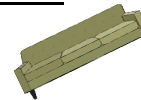

carpeting (rolled up)



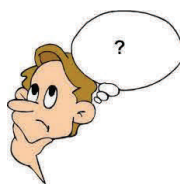
Separate metal items.

## Please Separate Yard Waste



In Monroe County, residential yard waste is collected separately from your trash and recycling service. Monroe County's yard waste is being composted and



**RECYCLED**

Do your part by following the simple rules below.

### Rules To Remember When Separating Yard Waste

- ⇒ Do not mix with trash.
- ⇒ Yard waste will not be accepted in plastic bags.
- ⇒ You may put out as many dedicated yard waste cans or bundles as needed.
- ⇒ Put yard waste that is less than 4" in diameter in a dedicated yard waste can. Weight limit 50lbs.
- ⇒ Bundle yard waste no more than 4 feet in length and tie with rope. Weight limit 50lbs.
- ⇒ For extra large loads, bulk pick up is available for a fee from your service provider.

Be careful not to contaminate.

If contaminated, it will end up in the trash.

### HOLDING YOUR NOSE AROUND THE CAN?

Try odor control trash bags.

Put a few scoops of odor control cat litter in the bottom of your can.

Put dryer sheets, new or used in the can.

A few scoops of baking soda or ground cinnamon works wonders.

Broken charcoal briquettes absorb odors.

Trash can deodorizers from the grocery store.

Wash and rinse your cans from time to time.
