Alarm System - Low Voltage* - Permit "Bulk" Application

Please complete the following application for purchase of Permit Labels and corresponding "Uniform Notice of Low Voltage Alarm System Project". (Pursuant to HB 241; Ch. 2017-52)**

A fee per the current Monroe County Building Department Fee Resolution will be charged per permit label. This fee is non-refundable. Any unused permit labels will not be refunded.

** Per FS 553.793: "Low-voltage alarm system project" means a project related to the installation, maintenance, inspection, replacement, or service of a new or existing alarm system, as defined in s. 489.505, that is hardwired and operating at low voltage, as defined in the National Electrical Code Standard 70, Current Edition...including but not limited to home-automation equipment, thermostats, closed-circuit television systems, access controls, battery recharging devices, and video cameras."*

*** Per HB 241 this Permit Label cannot be used for an alarm system project that includes a fire alarm system installation or replacement and a plan review is required by applicable fire code requirements.*

When power outlet or any other electrical system modification is required, a regular Alarm with Electrical permit must be obtained by an electrical contractor. • This Permit Label cannot be used for an alarm system project that includes a fire alarm system installation or replacement and a plan review is required by applicable fire code requirements. • The permit label is good for 1 year from issued date. Expired permit labels will be voided. • The contractor is required to post the label in a conspicuous location at each job site. • The "Uniform Notice of Low Voltage Alarm System Project" (bottom portion of the issued permit label) MUST be returned within 14 days of completing the project. Expired notices will not be accepted. • Disciplinary actions may be taken if a contractor fails to timely notify the agency of completion.
