

## Commercial Hazardous Waste Fees:

**Batteries:** NO CHARGE

**Electronic Waste:** \$.0618 /lb.

**Gasoline & Oily Water:** \$.78 /gal.

**Hazardous Waste:** \$.60 lb.  
*Up to 25 gal or 220 lbs.*

**Mercury-containing Bulbs:** \$.50 ea.

**Oil & Antifreeze:** NO CHARGE  
*5 gal. limit*



### Transportation Tips:

Transport no more than 25 gallons or 220 lbs. per trip. Multiple trips are allowed.

Never mix chemicals.

Place chemicals in sealed, preferably original containers.

Transport in trunk and pack to avoid spilling.

## Does your business generate hazardous waste?

If so, let us help - it can be expensive and difficult to dispose of chemicals, such as paint, motor oil, solvents, and acids.

Legally, they don't belong in the trash or down the drain; they are hazardous waste, and they must be specially managed and documented.

Monroe County has an affordable solution that may work for you.



### WE ACCEPT WASTE FROM

#### Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generators (CESQGs). Do you qualify?

- CESQGs generate 220 lbs. or less per month of hazardous waste or 2.2 lbs. or less of acutely hazardous waste per month
- CESQGs must identify all hazardous waste generated
- CESQGs can not accumulate more than 2,204 lbs. of hazardous waste at any time
- CESQGs must ensure that hazardous waste is delivered to a person or facility authorized to manage it.



### WE DO NOT ACCEPT WASTE FROM

#### Small Quantity Generators (SQGs).

SQGs generate more than 220 lbs. but less than 2,200 lbs. of hazardous waste.

## What's In It For My Business?

- A low-cost way to safely dispose of hazardous materials.
- Documentation that your business is properly managing its hazardous waste.
- Another level of protection: under "cradle to grave" laws, your business is responsible for the waste it generates. You can be held liable long after you've paid someone else to haul waste away.

With our program, Monroe County assumes generator responsibility for waste accepted. You can be assured that the material will be disposed of properly.

### HAZARDOUS WASTE (HHW)

- Paints, Stains, Strippers, Wood Preservatives
- Roof Tar & Patching Compounds
- Adhesives, Putty And Caulk
- Auto/marine Maintenance/care Products
- Fiberglass & Epoxy Resins
- Solvents — Acetone, Mineral Spirits, Etc.
- Hydraulic Fluids, Anti-freeze, Waste Oil
- Corrosives (Muriatic Acid, Lye, Etc.)
- Pesticides, Fertilizers And Weed Killer
- Household And Drain Cleaners
- Pool Cleaning Products
- Oily Water And Gasoline
- Fluorescent Bulbs, Cfl, Neon Bulbs, Switches, Thermometers
- Batteries - Ni-cd, Ni-mh, Li-ion, Ni-zn, Lead Seal, car, Button

### ELECTRONIC WASTE (E-WASTE)

- Televisions, Monitors, Computers, Lap Tops
  - Printers, Copiers, Fax Machines
  - Cell Phones, Radios, Speakers, Chargers
  - Discs, Video & Audio Cassettes, DVD/VCRs
- (No A/C Units, Refrigerators, Stoves, Freezers, or Dishwashers)

### NOT ACCEPTED:

- Ammunition (Contact Sheriff's Department)
- Flares (Contact Sheriff's Department)
- Medications (Contact Sheriff's Department)
- Needles/Bio-waste (Contact Fire Department)
- Radioactive Waste (Contact the EPA)
