

**12.5% CHARGED TO VISITORS
FOR LODGING ACCOMODATIONS IN

SALES TAX**

Six percent (6%) sales tax, one-half percent (.5%) discretionary sales surtax approved by voters in 1996, and one percent (1%) infrastructure tax approved by voters in 1989.

All funds from infrastructure tax go to Monroe County

**4%
TOURIST TAX**

This is the only part of the total twelve and one half percent (12.5%) that goes to the Tourist Development Council.

Two percent (2%) is for promotional purposes, event, and administration (referred to as "generic two penny funds").

Two percent (2%) is for District expenditures (referred to as "district two penny funds").

**1%
TOURIST IMPACT TAX**

Does not fund the Tourist Development Council. Approved by Monroe County voters in 1988.

Half (50%) of this tax goes to the County General Fund, the other half (50%) goes to the Land Trust (a portion of which goes to the City of Key West).
