

## FINAL PUBLIC NOTICE

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has received the subgrant application for Monroe County's Harry Harris Park repairs due to damages in Hurricane Irma (DR-4337-FL PW 07769). Pursuant to Executive Order 11988 and 44 CFR Part 9.12, final notice is hereby given of FEMA's intent to provide funding for this project under the Public Assistance (PA) Program.

An initial disaster-wide Public Notice was published October 06, 2017 for Hurricane Irma. Comments and other information received were fully evaluated by FEMA along with evaluation of social, economic, environmental, and safety considerations. This notice serves as a project-specific final notice for FEMA's funding action located within the floodplain.

Funding for the proposed project will be conditional upon compliance with all applicable federal, tribal, state and local laws, regulations, floodplain standards, permit requirements and conditions. This action complies with the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) requirements.

- Floodplain:** Project is located in the VE Zone, otherwise known as the Coastal High Hazard Area, per Monroe County FIRM Panel #12087C0938K dated 02/18/2005.
- Proposed Work and Purpose:** Monroe County will make various repairs within the park including replacement of equipment, landscaping elements, road and building components, etc. at the sports complexes, concession building, beach, lagoon, maintenance shop, and boat ramp. The repairs will be back to pre-disaster condition.
- Project Alternatives:** An alternative location is not practicable as elements are part of a larger facility and relocation may adversely impact social or economic resources for the community. The no action alternative is not feasible as the facility would continue to be vulnerable to further damages and pose safety hazards to the occupants and visitors.
- Comments:** This will serve as the final public notice regarding the above-described action funded by the FEMA PA program.
