WORK OVER THE WATER NOTICE

PERMITS FOR DOCKS, SEAWALLS, BOAT LIFTS OR ANY OTHER PERMITS WHERE IT MAY BE NECESSARY TO WORK OVER THE WATER (SUCH AS BUT NOT LIMITED TO BARGES AND BOATS) MUST HAVE THE FOLLOWING NOTICE SIGNED AND DATED BY THE CONTRACTOR AND OWNER AT THE TIME THE PERMIT IS ISSUED.

“FEDERAL LAW ENTITLES CERTAIN LAND BASED EMPLOYEES ENGAGED IN WORK ADJACENT TO NAVIGABLE WATERS, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO CONSTRUCTION WORKERS ON DOCKS, TO COMPENSATION FOR WORK-RELATED INJURIES. ACCORDINGLY, YOU MAY NEED TO OBTAIN INSURANCE COVERAGE UNDER THE LONGSHORE AND HARBOR WORKERS’ COMPENSATION ACT, 33 U.S.C. 901, ET.SEQ.”
