BUILDING PERMIT AND INSPECTION UTILIZATION REPORT

FISCAL YEAR 2019/20: OCTOBER 1, 2019 TO SEPTEMBER 30, 2020

Florida Statute 553.80 requires, by December 31, 2020, the governing body of a local government that provides a schedule of building permit fees shall create a building permit and inspection utilization report and post the report on its website. The information in the report shall be derived from relevant information available in the most recently completed financial audit. This is the Monroe County, Florida report based on fiscal year 2019/20.
