



BUSINESS IMPACT ESTIMATE¹

Proposed Ordinance Title/Reference: An Ordinance Amending Chapter 21 Solid Waste of Monroe County Code, and Section 21-46 Definitions to redefine certain terms to align to the County's Solid Waste Agreements; to outline services covered under the Agreements; providing receptacle and container requirements; and providing rules and requirements for garbage, recycling, yard waste and bulk waste pick-up.

The Proposed Ordinance does does not fall under one of the following enumerated exceptions:²

- The proposed ordinance is required for compliance with Federal or State law or regulation;
- The proposed ordinance relates to the issuance or refinancing of debt;
- The proposed ordinance relates to the adoption of budgets or budget amendments, including revenue sources necessary to fund the budget;
- The proposed ordinance is required to implement a contract or an agreement, including, but not limited to, any Federal, State, local, or private grant or other financial assistance accepted by the county government;
- The proposed ordinance is an emergency ordinance;
- The ordinance relates to procurement; or
- The proposed ordinance is enacted to implement the following:
 - a. Part II of Chapter 163, Florida Statutes, relating to growth policy, county and municipal planning, and land development regulation, including zoning, development orders, development agreements and development permits;
 - b. Sections 190.005 and 190.046, Florida Statutes, regarding community development districts;
 - c. Section 553.73, Florida Statutes, relating to the Florida Building Code; or
 - d. Section 633.202, Florida Statutes, relating to the Florida Fire Prevention Code.

Summary of Proposed Ordinance and Statement of Public Purpose to be Served:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MONROE COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AMENDING MONROE COUNTY CODE CHAPTER 21 SOLID WASTE, SECTION 21-46, DEFINITIONS, TO REDEFINE CERTAIN TERMS TO ALIGN TO OUR SOLID WASTE AGREEMENTS; OUTLINING SOLID WASTE SERVICES COVERED UNDER THE SOLID WASTE AND RECYCLING COLLECTION FRANCHISE AGREEMENTS; PROVIDING CONTAINER AND RECEPTACLE REQUIREMENTS; PROVIDING RULES AND REQUIREMENTS FOR GARBAGE, RECYCLING, YARD WASTE AND BULK WASTE PICK-UP. THIS ORDINANCE AMENDMENT WILL PROVIDE FOR A UNIFORM RECEPTACLE AND COLLECTION PROCESS WHICH WILL SUPPORT A FAIR AND CONSISTANT PROCEDURE FOR RESIDENTIAL COLLECTION AND FRANCHISEE COLLECTION.
