Proposed Ordinance Title/Reference: AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MONROE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE COUNTY'S CODE OF ORDINANCES, BY AMENDING CHAPTER 22, "SPECIAL DISTRICTS," ARTICLE VI, "OTHER MUNICIPAL SERVICE TAXING UNITS," SECTION 22-129, "FIRE AND AMBULANCE DISTRICT 1 CREATED," TO CLARIFY THE COMPOSITION OF THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF FIRE AND AMBULANCE DISTRICT 1; AND TO PROVIDE FOR SAME TO BE EFFECTIVE RETROACTIVELY TO MARCH 1, 2000, AND RATIFY ALL ACTIONS TAKEN BY THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS SINCE MARCH 1, 2000; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

The Proposed Ordinance **does** **does not fall under one of the following enumerated exceptions:**²

- The proposed ordinance is required for compliance with Federal or State law or regulation;
- The proposed ordinance relates to the issuance or refinancing of debt;
- The proposed ordinance relates to the adoption of budgets or budget amendments, including revenue sources necessary to fund the budget;
- The proposed ordinance is required to implement a contract or an agreement, including, but not limited to, any Federal, State, local, or private grant or other financial assistance accepted by the county government;
- The proposed ordinance is an emergency ordinance;
- The ordinance relates to procurement; or
- The proposed ordinance is enacted to implement the following:
 - a. Development orders and development permits, as those terms are defined in s. 163.3164, and development agreements, as authorized by the Florida Local Government Development Agreement Act under ss. 163.3220-163.3243;
 - b. Comprehensive plan amendments and land development regulation amendments initiated by an application by a private party other than the county;
 - c. Sections 190.005 and 190.046, Florida Statutes, regarding community development districts;
 - d. Section 553.73, Florida Statutes, relating to the Florida Building Code; or
 - e. Section 633.202, Florida Statutes, relating to the Florida Fire Prevention Code.

Summary of Proposed Ordinance and Statement of Public Purpose to be Served:

The composition of the Board of Governors for Fire and Ambulance District 1 of Monroe County, Florida, requires clarification concerning its membership to establish that at least three (3) members shall be designated from the Board of County Commissioners and at least one (1) member shall be designated from the City of Layton, with the Board of Governors being comprised of five (5) members total. The Board of County Commissioners specifically intend for this ordinance to have retroactive application to March 1, 2000 to the maximum extent permitted under law and in support of that intent the Board specifically finds that this ordinance does not create new obligations, impose new penalties, or impair vested rights, and instead creating continuity with existing practices.
